

BURSARY APPLICATION PROCESS



You can apply for a Bursary to support you while you study, you may be eligible for some of the following course related expenses:

- Travel if you live more than 1 mile away from your main campus of study
- Free college meals 16-18yrs (19-24 with an EHCP)
- Books, equipment or uniform that is essential to complete your course (costs will be transferred internally and essential items provided by the course department)
- Educational trips and visits only those approved by the college
- 19+ Adults Exam and/or professional membership fees if on a funded qualification, in exceptional circumstances
- 20+ Adults childcare expenses for the time you are in college, you must use an Ofsted registered childcare provider
- Other course related expenses only those approved by the college

You will need to read the appropriate Bursary Guidance to check for eligibility.

- 1. 16-18 Discretionary Bursary For learners aged 16-18
- 2. Vulnerable Bursary For learners aged 16-18 who fall in to one of the following categories:
 - · Are in care or
 - Are a care leaver (dependant on leaving care date)
 - · Are in receipt of benefits in their own right
- 3. 19+ Adult Bursary For learners aged 19 years and older on a funded qualification
- 4. Advanced Learner Loan Bursary For learners aged 19 years and older who have an approved Advanced Learner Loan to pay for their course.
