

FEES AND FINANCE INFORMATION

Students aged 16 - 18
Studying Further Education (FE)

16-19 (UNDER 19 ON 31ST AUGUST 2021)

If you are aged 16-18 and not studying elsewhere, you will not have to pay course fees for the majority of courses up to level 3.

Students may also be able to claim financial help towards the cost of coming to college. You can apply for bursaries and support outlined below.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (BURSARY) HOUSEHOLD INCOME LESS THAN £40K

The Financial Assistance is means tested, evidence of annual household income will be required when applying. Certain eligibility criteria will also apply. If eligible, students may receive one, or a combination of:

Network One Travel Pass (worth over £600 per year)



Free School Meals



College Equipment/Kit (on applicable courses)



Up to £1,200 (If in care, a recent care leaver or claiming certain benefits in own right)

CARE TO LEARN (CHILDCARE SUPPORT)

This financial assistance for FE students can help with the costs of studying at college.

If you are a parent, you could be entitled to help with childcare costs. For further information and / or to apply, visit - www.gov.uk/care-to-learn.

RESIDENTIAL BURSARY

Students living in our Halls of Residence, on pre-cadet or sport academy who are not receiving employer sponsorship can apply to the Financial Bursary for help towards their accommodation costs (Eligibility criteria may apply).
